•During this **full-day** course, Six Sigma Champions will obtain a high level review of the tools and techniques used by Six Sigma Improvement Teams and gain an understanding of the disciplines that a Black/Green Belt Team applies to a project.

Who Should Attend?

•This course is designed for individuals selected as Six Sigma Champions. A Champion is required to *remove barriers* and is held *responsible* for success or failure of the project.

The Champion should be any one of the following:

- Member of plant management
- Plant /Department/Area/Section/Project or Technical Manager
- Anyone **willing to champion** a Six Sigma project
- Anyone who can affect change** in the organization.
